### **Leading and Seizing Our Opportunities**

Ephesians 5:15-20

**Text:** "Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, making the most of the time, because the days are evil" (Eph. 5:15–16 RSV).

In today's text Paul was calling on the disciples of Jesus Christ in the city of Ephesus to walk in a manner worthy of their calling (Eph. 4:1–16), to walk differently from the pagan world about them (vv. 17–24), to walk in love (4:25–5:2). In the first part of chapter 5, he urged them to walk in the light as the sons of light (Eph. 5:5–14). In the words of our text, he encouraged them to walk with wisdom, seizing every opportunity to render service to God and to others.

Paul issued a call to walk in wisdom over against the folly of a pagan world. Wisdom is not an intellectual achievement but is a mind-set in which one seeks to do only those things that are pleasing to God. We are to snatch up all the opportunities that are available for doing God's will. Paul used the commercial vocabulary of the marketplace to describe the intense activity that he was encouraging each of them and us to put forth.

Some watch the stock market with intense interest because they are eager to seize bargains. They try to buy at the right time and sell at the right time in order to experience a profit. The apostle was encouraging this type of interest, energy, and ingenuity concerning spiritual opportunities for service. We are to seize an opportunity for service in the same manner that we would seize a bargain in the marketplace. The early Christians outlived, outthought, and outdid their contemporaries. That is what our present generation needs.

This is a call to a serious acceptance of our stewardship and time. Not one of us has as much time as we think we have. It is much later than we think. Our opportunities are rapidly slipping away from us. Each of us has an equal amount of time every day, and each must make the most of it.



Orville Kelly was the founder of an organization called Make the Day Count. Kelly founded this organization after discovering he was terminally ill with cancer. The purpose of the organization was to help those who were fatally ill face the realities of both their disease and their remain-

ing time. We need to stress the importance of the present and become intensely aware of the value of life and time. This would help us to learn what really matters and what doesn't.

Leaders think differently than followers. To be a leader, we must think like a leader. The following is a quick list of principles for developing a leadership mindset.

Accept and affirm the call to leadership. Be willing to accept the role and responsibilities without compulsion or obligation.

1 Peter 5:2 Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

1 Timothy 3:1 *This is a true saying, if a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work.*

Exercise the responsibilities of leadership conscientiously and thoroughly, not reluctantly or passively. Romans 12:8 Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness. You are no longer a follower, but a leader. Take responsibility.

Humbly accept and exercise spiritual authority as a leader operating under Christ's authority. The exercise of a leader's authority must always be to build up and empower, and to use for the collective good.

St. Matthew 20: 20 – 28; St. Mark 10: 35 – 45

1 Peter 5:3 Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being examples to the flock.

#### Be decisive and exercise initiative;

don't be indecisive and ambiguous. Make decisions and stick with them.
Acknowledge and admit wrong ones. Be proactive, not reactive.



**Be strong and courageous.** Even though you may be naturally timid, shy, or insecure, the Scripture calls for leaders to be strong and be courageous.

Joshua 1:6 Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them.

2 Timothy 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

Be bold, but not brash.

Be lead by God, not by the people. Do what God tells you to do. Avoid decisions made to appease people to keep a vocal minority of people happy. Remember Saul. 1 Samuel 15:24 And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

**Be people-centred** – a shepherd of those the Lord has entrusted to your care.

Acts 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

1 Peter 5:2, 4 Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

<sup>4</sup> And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

Love them. Take care of them in the way Jesus would want them cared for.

**Develop the practice of lifelong learning.** Be inquisitive, read widely, study often, think deeply, and reflect regularly.

Be secure in your leadership, calling, and position. Be comfortable in who you are (remembering that God is not finished). Leaders must manage their insecurities.

**Be like Jesus.** The pre-eminent way to develop the mindset of a leader is to learn from Jesus' life and leadership. Jesus embodies and exemplifies the mindset of the perfect and model spiritual leader.

Study the lives and leadership of other great leaders – either through observation, reading, or listening. Read biographies, ask questions, and study the principles and practices of successful leaders.

2 Timothy 2:2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

**LEAD!** One of the most effective ways to learn leadership is by being involved in leaders.

- Unite in our prayers over our communities and the nation as a whole


What this looks like:

I both encourage and challenge each region to develop a similar monthly Prayer Night, praying one for another (James 5:16, 1 Corinthians 12:24-26).

- Praying daily: one of the greatest gifts we received apart from salvation is the gifts of the Holy Spirit and the ability to speak in tongues to communicate with our Lord regarding His plan for our day. With daily prayer we will receive His thoughts over our own. (Isaiah 55:9)



# 200,000 children forced to learn in bullet-riddled classrooms!

Some 200,000 girls and boys in eastern Ukraine are commuting to schools whose classroom walls are often riddled with bullets, and playgrounds scattered with metal remnants of war.

That's according to the **United Nations Children's Fund**, UNICEF, in a statement released on Friday.

"Children are learning in schools with bullet holes in the walls and sandbags in windows, bomb shelters in the basements and shrapnel in school yards," said UNICEF's Ukraine Representative, Giovanna Barberis.

"The education system in eastern Ukraine has been in the crossfire for more than four years. All sides of the conflict must respect international humanitarian law and ensure that schools are safe places for children to learn."

More than four years of conflict in eastern Ukraine between government forces and separatists has taken a devastating toll on the education system. At least 45 schools have been damaged or destroyed over the last 16 months, in addition to the more than 700 schools affected overall since the conflict began.

"The children are extremely nervous of shelling and teachers try to calm them down, but it's hard for them." - Principal Elena Mihatskaya

Many schools and kindergartens are located along both sides of eastern Ukraine's so-called "contact line" that divides government and non-government-controlled areas. This means that classrooms are often close to military

bases and security check points, increasing the risk that they may step on unexploded weapons of war, or be caught in crossfire.



### Motion to Amend Passed

Whereas the present Constitution Article 7 A) specifies "The number of Executive Offices shall be fifteen (15)"; and

Whereas the present Bylaw Article 4 C) identifies 16 Executive Offices (General Secretary, Assistant General Secretary, General Treasurer, and the various Regional Secretaries - 13 in number); and

Whereas these two Articles are in conflict; and

Whereas our past practice has been to elect an Assistant General Secretary who is also a Regional Secretary, thereby adhering to Constitution Article 7 A) but not Bylaw Article 4 C);

Therefore, be it resolved to amend Constitution Article 7 A) as follows:

The powers of this organization shall be exercised and its affairs conducted by the Executive Officers. The number of the Executive Offices shall be the number of Regional Secretaries plus a minimum of two (2). The number of the Executive Officers provided for may be changed by a Motion at the National Convention increasing or decreasing the number of Regional Secretaries, providing the number not be allowed to decrease to a total less than five (5). Such a Motion must receive a minimum 2/3 majority support.

And further, be it resolved to amend Bylaw Article 4 C) by adding:

One of either the Assistant General Secretary or General Treasurer positions may also be occupied by an existing Regional Secretary.

# Grace Life Ministries Canada - Kell Frandsen

#### REPORT JUNE 2019 TO IAOGI:

We have recently returned from a great trip in our fields of ministry in both Nepal and India. It was great to have 3 young 15 year old boys join us on our travels and again a great mature team.

I am learning that close relationships are crucial to build the ministry. The young people became fast friends with the many young boys and girls that are part of the minis-

I really felt that God was encouraging us in seeing the fruit He has produced over these many years of ministry. Just in the last few days I received reports from our main leaders from our church planting ministries in Odisha. In our main village our facilities are already too small as so many are coming to Christ in the nearby communities. We love to hear reports like this!

God has also heard our prayers. We have been concerned that persecution has been increasing from radical Hindus. Again India has elected a fanatical Hindu party. Our ministries are in Odisha and once again we have a strong chief minister elected that guards the poor. In Andhra Pradesh where our main ministry centre is located, Jagan Reddy, who is Christian, came in with a massive majority. This means for us that we will have peace politically for the next 5 years in growing the ministry.

Our vision is to reach 2400 villages in the Kandhamal district. This has been a great Hindu stronghold for 5000 years and where the greatest persecution of Christians happened in India's history. God is opening great doors please pray that He will use us to reap this incredible harvest. Our amazing centre is now fully finished, we were all amazed at the great job Karuna, our main leader, did!

We had a very special trip into Nepal and met with our Grace Life Nepal leaders in Chitwan. My friend, an 87 year old former pastor and missionary, gave me wise advice - he said leave everything for Jesus to organize in Nepal.

God has opened a number of doors during this trip which we can pursue in the future. We have 5 different directions we can pursue. Solomon gave advice in Ecclesiastes 11:1-6 that is to divide your endeavours into several directions since we don't know which will succeed. We will pursue all 5 doors that God has opened in Nepal! Again, we covet your prayers!!!

Our team was able to spend almost 2 weeks in Singapore. The heads of Onesimus Ministries were able to join us in India which was great. We connected with a very large ministry that does front line rescue of girls caught in the sex slave trade. The leader I met had personally rescued more than 4000 underage girls. Their team consist of very highly trained teams that are from military, police, and justice background. GLM is interested to restore these rescued girls. Leading them to Christ, giving them a safe place to heal and also training so that they can make their own livelihood. This ministry will need large resources as well as involvement from many people from different fields of expertise.

Our great friends in Singapore are also organizing to work together with many missions that work in South East Asia to draw from each other's strengths. We have an open invitation to be involved as well so this is a very exciting new opportunity for the ministry. We seriously appreciate IAOGI and that you bear us on your hearts!

#### The Preakness, a Town called Unity and Revival in Canada

I have just returned from the Battle for Canada held in Edmonton, Alberta. This was a follow-on gathering from the first Battle for Canada held in North Battleford, Saskatchewan, 70 years after the Latter Rain Outpouring that sprang up there and impacted the world. One of the things that resulted from that move of God that began in 1948 was that it spread from North Battleford to Edmonton where Charles S. Price held miracle meetings. These meetings resulted in so many miracles that people climbed the building and tore holes in the roof to beg for seats to get in. They actually threw money down for people to give up their seats for them.

During the Battle for Canada meetings a very interesting thing took place - the second leg of the Triple Crown Race, or the Preakness, was run. Something very unusual happened during that race which spoke to me about revival in Canada. At the beginning of the race, as the horses were in the stalls waiting for the bell to ring, the handler of one of the horses did something that startled the horse and when the gate opened, the horse bolted and the jockey fell off! The horse then began to run the race without a rider and looked like it was trying to win! When the race was completed, the rider-less horse continued on the track and began to circle around again at top speed. Race officials had to rush in to stop the horse, for fear that it would injure or kill itself from exertion. This was such an unusual visual that I felt that there was a message in it. First of all, the horse had no jockey. With this move of God that is upon us, I feel the Lord is saying that there can be no "jockeying" for position. Whenever there is competition, God steps aside. The next part of the visual was that there was no rider on the horse. The only "rider" that God has for Canada is the one on the white horse Who is named, Faithful and True. When He is not on the horse, we will run, but we cannot win the race. Such a run is doomed for failure. Canada is destined for a distinct move of God that results in an entire nation becoming a resting place for God. It is not about jockeying to see who comes out on top but rather to have our eyes fixed on the rider on the white horse.

While I was flying to Edmonton for the meetings, I had a Godencounter on the plane. I had just finished watching a movie when I

began to feel an unusual presence of God come over me. I decided to switch on the map to see where we were and how long until we landed. As I did this, the presence of God became so strong on me that I was almost overcome. On the map we were flying directly over North Battleford! A little further to the left was a town called "Unity". It was unusual as I had never heard of such a town. Immediately what came to mind was Bob Jones' prophecy about the next move of God which would be marked by Psalm 133 unity.

As I was taking this all in and the strong presence of God on me, I looked again and the map said "North Battleford, 48" indicating the number of miles we were away from it and "Unity, 24" Since the Latter Rain Revival began in North Battleford in 1948, I waited for the Lord to speak about Unity 24. Immediately I thought of Psalm 24. "Lift up your heads, O ye gates and be ye lifted up you everlasting doors, that the King of Glory may come in. Who is the King of Glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord, mighty in battle". The Lord was saying that as we come together in unity, He will lead the battle for Canada. The rider on the horse. It was amazing that a First Nations lady opened the Battle for Canada meetings with Psalm 24, the very scripture God gave me on the plane.

When I got home and was telling the story, one of our members asked if I had looked up the town Unity to see what it was about. When I did, I discovered that Unity is an intersection town. It sits at the intersection of Highways 14 and 21 in Saskatchewan and is also located at the intersection of the CN and CP railways. When we visited Shanghai, China, several years ago we went to an acrobatic show entitled "ERA, an intersection of time". Many prophets are saying that we are entering into a new ERA. We have come to an intersection of time for Canada. We are entering into a destiny moment. God is clearly speaking to Canada that as we come into unity as the remnant church, as we look to the King of Glory to come to find a resting place here, as we lay down our need to lead, He will take His place to truly make Canada glorious and free.

### **Default Driving**

It's amazing how you can see disaster coming and not be able to do anything about it. A few weeks ago I ran out to get some pizza, and I used a side street by my condo. There was a small sedan in front of me indicating that he was turning left. In Canada we drive on the right hand side of the road. This man turned left into the left side of traffic, and drove down the road. At this point there was traffic coming towards him, but he didn't stop!

He bumped cars and the curb, and then tried to turn right to get to the correct side of the road! Into oncoming traffic! People did the best they could – they stopped moving, they tried honking at him, they tried changing lanes to go around him, but he just kept on driving that car into traffic. By the time he was done he had hit 6 cars, and he turned the corner and just kept driving. I sat at the stop sign with my mouth dry from hanging open so long in disbelief. I mean, he didn't stop; he just kept driving! I heard a honk behind me and there was a line of people who couldn't see what I was staring at. I went and picked up my pizza still shaking my head.

The best explanation I had was that he was from a country that drove on the left side of the road, and in his comfort forgot where he was. Now, he had a passenger in the car, and I could see that they were trying to direct him. But he still didn't stop. I realized that I should have given my name as a witness, but when I went back it had all cleared up. I don't think anyone was injured, but the car damage was 6 cars!

My church recently had Dr. Mike Brown for a conference and he told a similar story of the opposite – a person who normally drove on the right side of the road was in England and was driving fine until they came to a roundabout. They made it through ok, but when they exited the round-about they defaulted to the right hand side. It was where they were comfortable. Thankfully for them it was a safe quick move back to the left hand side of the road.

Our flesh is like that default we have, that comfortable place we automatically go to when we need it, when we're distracted, or when life is too busy. I'm sure there are many people who watch others "drive into oncoming traffic" with their lives, and they are helpless to prevent it from happening.

How important it is to always listen to the Holy Spirit, to hear His direction, and obey what He says. It will keep us at peace while we wait at the side street to turn left across 2 lanes of traffic, increasing pressure building in the cars behind us, and to see the clear gap between the traffic to safely turn and go our way. Just think of how smoothly our lives would be if we all did this!

Jesus gave us the Holy Spirit to help us, and we have free access to hear Him and obey. We should definitely use that gift as much as we can!
