A TIME OF TRANSITION - MOSES IS DEAD

Has someone ever stated the obvious to you? Like, "Hey, did you know your shoes are brown?" "Well, yes I did, Einstein!".... "Good deductive reasoning there, Sherlock!" Kids are great at this.

But there is always something behind what they are saying, like "I have a pair too!" You just have to dig a little deeper for the meaning

Joshua 1:1-2

After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, it came to pass that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: 2 "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the

children of Israel."

God tells Joshua "Moses is dead" stating the obvious, but what was He really saying? Joshua was stuck in a mindset and God needed him to change that mindset.

Moses was the greatest leader of the Israelites, he was given the law and commandments, he was given great miracles and powers, and now he was dead and Joshua had to follow in his footsteps; only God had something different for Joshua. God wanted Joshua to be Joshua, not to be Moses. Joshua's calling was unique to him.

God tells Joshua, Moses is dead. It's time to stop grieving. In order for Joshua to go forth and do what God was calling him to do, he needed to stop grieving over the past. Moses is in the past. God gave Israel a certain number of days to grieve. Numbers 20:29 and Deuteronomy 3.



2 Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

I became an overcomer. I became more than a conqueror.

Romans 8:31-37

"What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us. 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us."

It is time to transition.

I. A. O. G. I. (Canada) has a work for you to do. God had a big work for Joshua to do. He needed Joshua's head to be in the right place in order to be victorious.

Romans 12:1-2

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God."



Notice that renewing our minds INCLUDES presenting our lives as a living sacrifice. The two go hand in hand. First surrender, then you can work on renewing the mind. Why must the mind be renewed?

Proverbs 23:7

"For as he thinks in his heart, so is he. "Eat and drink!" he says to you, But his heart is not with you."

Your actions will follow your thought life. The mind is powerful. Even Joshua had to be reassured by God's Word. Move on, there is a work for you to do! God needs you to recognize that it's time to move.

Moses is dead, God is doing something new.

Joshua's calling was not the same as Moses. Why? Because Joshua was a different man than Moses. Moses was meek;

Joshua was a warrior. They were both great leaders but had completely different missions and different styles of leading.

You are different from others; therefore, your calling is not the same as another's. I have never seen God use two people in the exact same way! God wants to do something new in your life. He makes you unique from others. You have different thought processes, different views and actions. You are DIFFERENT.

God wants to use you, but do not expect it to look the same as another's ministry. God is doing something new, do not expect it to look like the same way He did last time.

Joshua and the Israelites had to be warriors now, not the grumblers and complainers as their fathers. God does not make cookie-cutter people. God wants to do something NEW in your life!

We are coming into a new season, embrace the new. God constantly works in the "new"

Isaiah 43:19

"Behold, I will do a new thing, Now it shall spring forth; Shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert."

God is raising up Joshua's that are ready and willing to go out and take down the giants in Jesus' name! Let HIM work in your life. Do not fight against it. God wanted Joshua to know that He would be with him just like He was with Moses.

Joshua 1:5 -9

"No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. 6 Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. 7 Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. 8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. 9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

The Lord wants you to know that whatever He has called you to do - HE WILL GO WITH YOU! God never leaves you alone to go and do it yourself. He equips you. He strengthens you.



MINISTRY UPDATES

GRACE LIFE MINISTRIES - MIRACLE UPON MIRACLE

We are thrilled to report great news from our leaders in the field in India. God is multiplying His work even amid great challenges and difficulties. Just last week we had 7 new baptisms in a main area of our ministry in Odisha. For 5000 years, dark religions like those mentioned in Old Testament times have reigned in India.

The areas we work in are tribal areas where animism has been practiced for millennia. Humans were sacrificed and their blood sprinkled on the fields to appease ancient gods. Yet God has prepared this field over the last 100 years through missionaries who sowed the seed of the gospel.

Right now, we are seeing much Christian persecution around the world and God's church is praying that God will bring in a great harvest. Recently, a main village leader and important businessperson who could not walk was HEALED! He is now attending church.

The town drunk who had been addicted from a young age has been DELIVERED! Formerly bedraggled and unkempt, he now dresses befitting

a child of the King, and he is now in

fellowship. The villagers are amazed at how our Lord has changed this man.

This month we started two more daycares in Odisha to look after vulnerable children. We are feeding them, instructing them about Christ, and tutoring them. Local schools have not been operating properly in the last two years, so these daycares are meeting a significant need. We also continue to look after destitute widows which is a growing problem in these poor states.

Our ministry teams travel to unreached villages. In one such village there was a young family where the husband was totally paralyzed on one side. THE LORD HEALED HIM! He has taken baptism and his whole family has come to Christ, including over 20 others who want to make a commitment to the Jesus they know is real. But as usual there is

also trouble. The oldest daughter of our main field pastor was brutally attacked by her radical, unbelieving husband. Her leg was almost hacked off. We had her treated at a proper hospital.



She had to have a metal rod inserted as her leg bone had been destroyed. By God's grace the surgery was a success. The doctors are shocked at how fast she is healing. She has also made a deep commitment to Christ after being overwhelmed with our love and prayers. She is only 26 years old. The husband has a history of crime and violence and is now in jail.

Our main headquarters is in Visakhapatnam AP. We work in the slums looking after the needs of children through daycare programs touching hundreds. We also have home care for children. These are children we choose out of our daycare program or from very

poor villages. These are ones where parents, and the kids themselves, allow us to take care of them fully, including opportunity for higher education. The families keep their strong family ties.

We have chosen 22 new young boys and girls for this part of our program. This month 5 young people who have been in our care, since they were very young, will graduate. Four will graduate with engineering degrees and one in law enforcement. All have done extremely well!

We have 7 new students entering various degree programs. There are 3 others in nursing. Our main village pastor's daughter just got the highest marks in her nursing class! Her brother is being trained to be a veterinarian. We just love these amazing young people that are like family to us. We have lived with them and looked after them from a very young age.





The first young girl we took into our home program is now a pediatric nurse having done her RN degree. Devi is a great miracle. She needed protection as her home situation was dangerous to a young pretty girl. She was part orphan so I became her father. She was not naturally scholastically inclined, but she worked very hard and succeeded! She is an amazing very wise young woman. Because of her maturity commitment to Christ she has joined our leaders on our India trust. Last month.

June 1st, she married a wonderful Christian young tech engineer. It is sooooo amazing to see these miracles of changed lives!

What a great privilege we all have to serve our amazing Jesus Christ in His quest to seek and save lost humanity! Paul encourages us and his son Timothy in 1 Timothy 1:14 "The Grace of our Lord (ie. God's

supernatural ability) was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus." Abundance means over and beyond what we need. God has given great abundance to the ministry, and we rejoice in Him for giving us our very best year!

Please continue to pray for Grace Life Ministries and all we are involved with.



THE CLEANSING POWER OF THE BLOOD

Have you ever had a blood pressure cuff on your arm, and feel some discomfort, maybe even some pain? I was getting some blood work done a month or so ago, and they had trouble finding a vein for the blood tests. They ended up putting the BP Cuff on my arm and had me clench my fist over and over again. She then stopped me before I went any further.

You see, if I continued, due to the blood flow being restricted to the rest of my arm, I would have experienced cramping, severe pain, and finally agony.

This is due to the toxins building up in my arm without the blood being able to wash the toxins away. These waste products, or metabolites, accumulate in our cells and need to be cleansed by the stream of blood that flows through our body's wonderful blood system.

Our great creator new what He was doing when He made our bodies with the cleansing power of the blood. Consider the following:

THE GREAT TRANSFER

- Rev. 7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they? 14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

The same living blood that bathes every cell with the nutrients of life, also carries away all the accumulated waste and refuse of our sins and transgressions, by His blood we are forgiven, through His blood, we are made clean.

Come back to the power of the precious blood of Jesus. Be bold in your righteousness. Stand strong that you have been cleansed. Exercise your faith in the power of His blood.

"Just call me, Paul." That is how Rev. Paul McPhail, our General Secretary Emeritus often introduces himself. Being a member of the next generation, you can imagine the looks I would get, when I referred to this man of God, and leader of our fellowship as simply, Paul. But I do my best to honor his request.

In May, I sat down with Paul at breakfast during our 104th Annual National Convention. It was set to be a major week. It was the first time our fellowship had gathered in person since the pandemic but also, Paul had announced the



year prior that he would not accept the senior leadership position of General Secretary come 2022. I peppered the man with questions about his seventeen consecutive years of leadership and was quite content to listen to the wisdom and stories that promptly followed.

"You're going to be the next General Secretary." the senior saint told Paul prior to any election. "I didn't really know it till then." Paul recalled. That was back in 2005 when Paul was first elected. From that point on, no other names would come forward. Every year, Paul remained the General Secretary by acclamation; trusted and backed by the full confidence of our fellowship.

As many of you know, Paul has always been a bit of Church History buff. He can tell you how and where different "streams" joined and separated, notable moments of the move of the Holy Spirit and so much more. After growing up in a pastor's home, pastoring for over 40 years and having been with the fellowship since December 1987, he's seen a few things first-hand too. All that history and experience always serves him as a springboard for what God's doing today and how we, as His ministers, can partner with Him.

That being said, over the past seventeen years of his leadership, Paul has led our fellowship in some notable ways:

Champion of Women Ministers - while the IAOGI fully supports women in ministry, not all ordained women had been formally registered with the government. Paul set the record straight. When a woman regional representative was elected but then placed as an understudy to the former regional, Paul set the record straight. "Our constitution and statement of faith are clear. There is no delineation between male or female ministers."

Champion of Honor - an outstanding amount was owed to the former general secretary prior to Paul. Paul led the fellowship in making sure it got paid in full without going into debt. Our regional representatives are a volunteer role. Paul led the fellowship in taking care of their expenses annually in coming to the National Convention. The General Secretary originally paid his own expenses to visit the ministers across Canada and travel to represent the fellowship. Paul led in having a travel fund put in place to support the work of the ministry of the IAOGI.

Champion of Reconciliation and the Body of Christ - I have never seen someone so embody the term "Minister of Reconciliation". Paul has put the hand of fellowship out first toward so many others and even other denominations where great hurt and grievous splits occurred. He has repaired bridges that were previously blown to bits and built bridges where none had yet been established. "Have you met so and so…

they are with A, B, C and have done 1, 2, 3... you should meet them; you'll be blessed." These are often his introductions.

Champion of the Called and the Next Generation - You won't find a bigger supporter in the ministry than Paul. He'll take the call at 3am. He'll pour in the oil and wine to the minister and their family. He pastors the pastors, propelling them to "the next" with wisdom, encouragement, compassion, vision and such a great love. "Can you see yourself going there? I can." I've compared notes with our ministers and often we have the same stories; the time Paul Fill in the blank, which meant so much and made such a difference. I take the time to write these things out to encourage you all. You are doing well! Stay the course. Trust the Holy Spirit's ideas, champion the body of Christ, know that people are blessed and can see Jesus in you. Trust the Holy Spirit's nudges on transition and transition well.

Now, Paul's not dead, and God's not done with Paul. He'll continue pastoring in Chatham, Ontario, leading his international Bible School and counselling and loving the body of Christ; but let's not wait till someone is promoted to glory to celebrate the gift of God in them.

God has done many great things! We are excited about this next chapter with Rev. David Kelsey and the other changes in our leadership. Just as we have come to trust Paul, the Holy Spirit within him and his leadership of our fellowship, we are pleased to do the same with Rev. David Kelsey. Let us agree as IAOGI family to believe the Holy Spirit to direct Rev. Kelsey as he steps forward in this new role and those transitioning with him.

We are grateful for the work and ministry God has done through Paul in our fellowship and for moving us forward. There are many adjectives and titles for leaders and great men of God such as him, but I just call him, Paul.
