HEARING EARS

Revelation 2:7 He who has an ear, let him hear.

In late December, as I was asking the Lord what to speak on in the New Year, he took me to Revelation 2:4 - you have left your first love. **But verse 7 was the key**, 'He who has an ear to hear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying.'



GRACE LIFE MINISTRIES

It is so very incredible that we have such a great base of generous sponsors, prayer warriors, and friends in this ministry! Thanks to your support, we had a very great year. God is multiplying all we are doing. I will highlight this in this brief report: Our very special friends and church community in Wales have contributed very generously to many projects. Recently one of our young leaders needed help. The wife was expecting a baby and would have to birth through Caesarian. The Welsh church sent the funds, and you can see this very beautiful little girl born at the very beginning of this year. What a great way to celebrate the beginning of a New Year!





We have incredibly wonderful young men who have completed several degree programs in university. Pictured are a few of these young people with our main leader, Karuna. They are pursuing careers in engineering, law enforcement and computer software. After finishing their degrees, they stay with us for another two years to help with the ministry as they also pursue their new professions. One of the young graduates wishes to be full time with the ministry. Also, we have opened opportunities for more young adults to pursue nursing. We have two in a degree program; one will finish her degree this year. We added two girls from the villages into general nursing. What's so great about this is that in a few years their lives will have opened up for a successful life and they will no longer have to battle poverty!

We have one young lady (our leader's daughter) who is in pre-

med in order to pursue a career as a paediatric doctor. This year we have chosen fourteen very special young men. They will be trained for the ministry. They will learn practical ways to help in the villages. There is a great deal to do as we take on more daycare children and destitute widows. Along with that there is the spiritual work of helping bring the good news to the hundreds of villages. They will begin training in Visakhapatnam shortly before they join in a practical hands-on ministry in Odisha. They will be fully supported by GLM for likely half the year during the dry season. We can use financial help in this area.

Pictured is our acreage in our main village that was mostly sponsored by a Rotary grant and by



individual Rotarians. The field is used to plant rice in the wet season; as soon as that harvest is brought in, many different vegetable crops are grown. Plants grow very quickly with irrigation and lots of sunshine, so they can harvest at least 3 crops per year including the rice crop.

As reported, we have 12 destitute widows whom we look after, making sure they

are loved and taken care of. James said: "This is pure and undefiled religion before our God and Father, taking care of orphans and widows in their need." James 1:27. Recently 2 widows passed away, surrounded by people who truly cared for them. We will add many more this year.

Finally, 2022 ended with great Christmas celebrations in Visakhapatnam, with hundreds of our daycare children and their families in attendance. In the villages many hundreds came for the delicious chicken and biriani feast, hosted in our large church centre (fully finished with a recent new sound system). It was an incredible time for everyone. Many leaders, local politicians and business leaders have made decisions for Christ and others have expressed the desire to be baptized. Consequently, our main village is now 100% believers in Christ. A main leader said to me: "This is a very great miracle." We thank you all for being a part of all these great exploits God has done!

The biggest challenge was that almost everyone over the age of 10 is illiterate. We foresee this as an immediate challenge that we need to take care of.

Another challenge is that many of the couples who have children and grandchildren were not married. We immediately took this in hand and were able to have one couple married. We would have had more, however many of the couples did not have their birth certificates yet to finalize the marriage. Thankfully they are all working on it.

We believe we are experiencing a mini revival, for many gave their hearts to the Lord and during my stay and we baptized 21 people. Praise God!

PLEASE PRAY! Just within my two weeks stay there were two attempt suicide cases and one homicide for children under the age of eighteen. This is a satanic attack on the young people. Unfortunately, one of suicide attempts ended up fatal. However, with the other suicide attempt, we were able to spend time with the young lady to minister and pray with her. As a result, she accepted the Lord into her life. We believe this was a miracle and divine timing. Praise the Lord!

Please join with us in agreement that the move of the Holy Spirit currently being experienced in the river areas will spread to the other surrounding areas. We are also praying that the Lord will speak to more



believers and will send someone to minister to these troubled children as well. Our hearts are moved with great compassion for them.

Greetings Fellow Workers,

My Prayers are with you all and may you take strength from 1 Corinthians 3:9 (FNV) "For we are working side by side with the help of the Great Spirit. You are Creator's garden where he grows good fruit, and you are the sacred lodge where he has chosen to live.".

I will admit that there are times when I, for one, wondered at the size of the garden/task before me. I was so worried about my indigenous charges, in particular the youth, for it seemed that they were in a spiral of despair. Then Covid hit and, well I too, lapsed into what will I/we do? However, God had a huge message/task in the works. In fact, it was 1000's years in the making.

You see, our Indigenous Ministry has been growing over these years and we in conjunction with other organizations are starting to send international workers to the world mission field! My brother David was the First Indigenous Missionary for one organization, and he was sent to the Kurdistan region of the Middle East. Such a milestone for our people and these organizations.

There he found great acceptance and I'll let his words tell you:

"The people that I am working with have stories and legends that say the Kurdish people and some of the First Nations people come from the same tribe. Around 4,000 years ago, we were one tribe from this area. The tribe, for some reason, had to divide and part of the tribe stayed here and the other part crossed through Russia into North America. This story is also told in our stories, so with both cultures having the same story this has opened the door for me to be looked at not as a foreigner but as a distant brother".

So, God brought a "Distant Brother" to the Kurdish People. One larger question the Kurdish Elders asked was about the "Christian invasion" and how did it affect our people? The answer given is that God the Creator has revealed things that we did need.

Yes, there were hard times, but Jesus, Creator Sets Free, and opens the eyes and hearts of all who allow. The very next, thing was given by God. You see, they have a very similar scourge as we do here in Canada. Their sisters have been stolen by evil. Here we call it: *Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG*). Since we have been ministering in this area here at home, this ministry was now transferred to the Kurdish People.

I was greatly encouraged. I was taught that all the hard times of wondering if I was moving in ministry with my people, was indeed following the EXACT plan that God had set forth, for on the other side of the World, God would be victorious. Fellow ministers, I plead, do not lose heart, and always reach out to your fellow workers both

inside and outside the IAOGI for they are the community of God, called to do the greatest of miracles. Even a miracle, 1000s of years in the making in sharing the good news to our distant brothers.

NOTICE OF MOTION:

Currently in the IAOGI Constitution the following is stated:

Article 2C) The majority of the members present shall represent a quorum. Each member present at the meeting shall have the right to exercise one (1) vote.

I would like to make a motion that a committee be formed during the 2023 Annual Business meeting and tasked to review options in regard to remote or absentee voting for IAOGI members in good standing who may not be available to be in person at our Annual Business Meeting as required by the above article. The goal of this committee would be to fully research and review absentee or online voting options in order to present this information and have a response by motion at our next Annual Business Meeting in 2024 for our membership's consideration. It is recommended that this committee consist primarily of members from each region, as well as a board representative.

In our last National convention, lest than 21% of our voting members were able to be present. At that time, the consensus on the floor regarding introducing remote and/or absentee voting, was that further information is needed before making any decision, in order that such a constitutional change would be both beneficial and considerate of all members. The motion at hand now ensures continued forward discussion regarding the topic. There are various reasons why members cannot attend in person, but now with the option of holding the Annual Business Meeting and National Conventions online, it seems appropriate to include members who cannot travel. Remote and/or absentee voting would allow missionaries, those with health conditions, financial and logistical hindrances to be included and give further voice to our fellowship as a whole as we make decisions together.

Dad was raised in a household where they may not have known where their next meal would come from but there was no doubt a meal would come. The table would be set, the children would sit down, a prayer would be said over the non-existent meal. After the prayer, a knock would be heard on the door. The need was met. God was always faithful. He always showed up and met the need. No matter what the need was.

Now that I have laid a little foundation so that you can know what type of home my Dad was raised in, I will share my story. Because he was influenced greatly by the faith that his mother had. He was raised in a home filled with faith and trust in God. There was no wavering in that home. He knew that Nan only had God to depend on because naturally speaking there was no one else in her life but God. He truly was the husband to the widow that lived on First Avenue in Badger, NL.

In 1962 our little town was affected by polio. Little was known about this new disease, but it was known that it was very serious, and children were being greatly affected. Some had died. Some couldn't walk. Others were battling it. It was rampant at the time. Everyone was talking about it and how serious it was.

I was one of the children that were affected. For 6 days I lay in my bed with a high fever. I couldn't eat. I couldn't move. My face was covered in sores from the fever. My whole body was trapped in that bed. I had no energy. For 6 days, my Dad prayed and fasted. He knew that God was a God of healing. A God of miracles. He had seen it in his Mother's house time and time again. As the days passed; however, things appeared to be getting worst. With each passing day there was no improvement.

Even though in the natural it looked bleak, Dad wasn't dealing in the natural. He was dealing in the spiritual. He knew that God would be faithful. He was often heard saying, "When you know that you know!" He knew that no matter what God was at work, and he just had to keep believing that God was at work. He trusted and believed.

On the 7th day, a Sunday, Dad entered into my room to pray again. But this time there was a supernatural shift in the atmosphere. Things were about to radically change. Dad lay hands on me and spoke into my little body. Health, wholeness, total restoration. The Spirit of God entered that little bedroom and bed. Instantly, I was restored to health. The fever was gone. I sat up in bed as if I hadn't just fought the greatest battle a little four-year old could have ever faced.

I smiled and looked at Mom. My words were, "Can I have some toast and molasses bread?" As Mom went to prepare the toast, Dad literally ran to the church. He couldn't wait to share what God had just done in his home. I guess you can say he yelled it from the top of a chair seat. The God that he had put his faith in had done exactly what He said he would do. Dad's faith was fixed on Him just like it says in Isaiah 41:10, "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness."

And now, as a part of the great commission that we are all called to, "Let us go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and the Holy Spirit".

Article 3 Credentials

(H) Credential certificates will be issued with the name of the credential holder, the sponsoring church, sponsoring pastor, and the General Secretary of the IAOG. They will include an official seal, date of certification, specification of either ordination, licensing, or Commissioned Christian Worker.
